ABSTRACT REQUIREMENTS

1. TEXT BONDARIES

Top, left, right – 2,5 cm; bottom – 2,0 cm; interval – 1,5 cm.

2. TITLE OF THE ARTICLE

Times New Roman, 14 pt., bold, alignment centered). New line (interval – 1cm).

3. AUTHOR

(Times new roman, 14 pt., Bold, Alignment centered), scientific degree and name of institution (Italic), ORCID, author (s) email. New line (interval – 1cm).

4. ABSTARCT

(Times new roman 10pt, Justify, alignment left) maximum 200 words should be entitled: **ABSTRACT**, followed by the essence and importance of your work on French or English languages.

5. ABSTARCT IS FOLLOWED BY KEY WORDS

(Times new Roman 10 pt., Alignment left, Italic).Should be titled: **KEY WORDS**: maximum 5 words, Italic, in alphabet order. New line (interval– 1cm).

6. THE CONTENT OF THE ARTICLE:

- **TEXT** must be typed with text editor as Word, font – Times new Roman, 12 pt., 1,5 cm interval, Alignment justify. The volume of a scientific article should not exceed 8 pages (an even number). In the text, quoted sources are indicated in square brackets in a sequential order with specifying the pages. As an example: [1, p.35], [2], ..., [n].
- **EQUATIONS, FORMULAS AND SYMBOLS** should be located on the left side of the page and numbered in consecutive order by Arabic numerals, according to the international numbering system. Each equation must be separate from above and below the main text by an interval.
- **PHOTOS, DRAWINGS AND TABLES** should be located in the central part of the page and separated by blanks from above and below of the main text. Scanned tables are not allowed.
- **CONCLUSIONS** should reflect the author(s)'s point of view on the subject and result of the study.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- The authors of the article bear all responsibility for the correctness of calculations, experimental data and scientific interpretations, as well as for the accuracy of editing in Romanian, English, French or Russian languages.
- The submission of the article(s) implies that it is original and has not previously been published (it is not currently the subject of publication) in other publications.
- Materials which are executed with violations of given requirements are not accepted for publishing.
- Articles drawn up with a deviation from the editing requirements, with expired terms of filing, will not be accepted for publication.

7. BIBLIOGRAPHY

(Times new Roman,12 pt., Bold, Alignment left). The following order in the bibliography should be followed: the author's surname and initials, the title of work, the publishing house, publishing place and the year of publication, in alphabetical order.
